Along with our long term collaborators Cirkus Brazil Jack we staged the first circus parade in Malmö for 40 years to mark the company's 125 years anniversary. Classical and contemporary circus working with each other to make a spectacle that got us into the news and brought hundreds of people into Brazil Jack's big top for their masterful show.

Circus and the people who make it are so often full of surprises, so often leaders by example and wonderful friends in hard times. I know that our work as Cirkus Syd brings more power to those to make and share circus with the world and I look forward to being part of the world we create together.

## **ACTIVITIES:** LOCAL

## **ACTIVITIES:** NATIONAL

Sometimes our events take place in the local area but have a national scale and that was the case of the Southern Sweden Circus Festival (SSCF), which took place across Skåne in September 2024. This was the first edition of this biennale and it was produced by Cirkus Syd in collaboration with Lund & Malmö municipalities.

Cirkus Syd's vision is that by 2030 SSCF will be the largest circus festival in the Nordic region. We want Skåne and the municipalities within it to be internationally known as great places to experience and create high quality circus.

The festival was built around themes of large scale spectacles, city-touring, regional development & collaboration, representation, engagement & wellbeing, and innovation.

# INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS

NEW HORIZONS LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME (NHLP-EU) NHLP-EU is a Baltic-Nordic collaboration with European dimension which took place in 2023-2024, led by Cirkus Syd (SE), Rigas Cirks (LV), and DYNAMO (DK) and co-funded by the European Union.

The vision for NHLP-EU is to strengthen the position of the circus field in Europe by supporting future leaders to acquire and develop skills and competencies for strong leadership.
